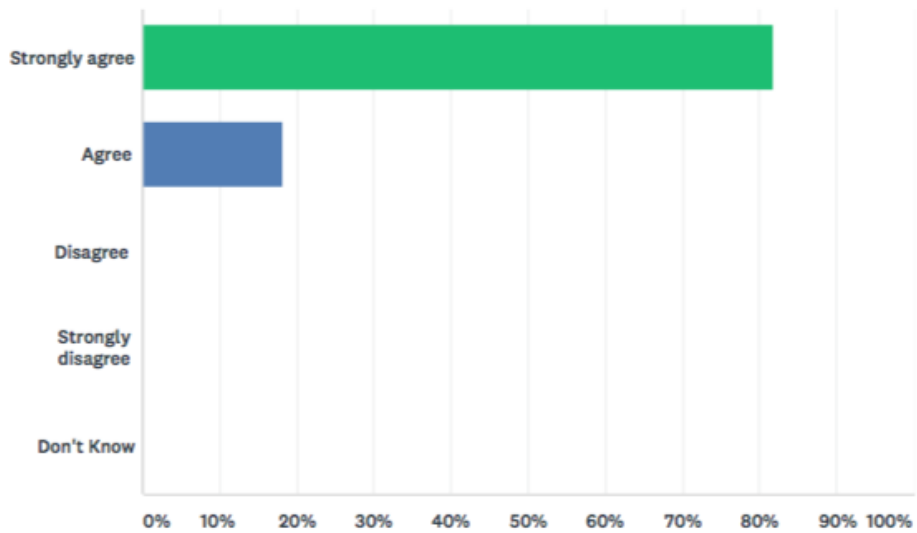


# Shaw Education Trust Ofsted Style Survey June 2019

Question 1 and 2 asked participants to select the name of their child's school and year group.

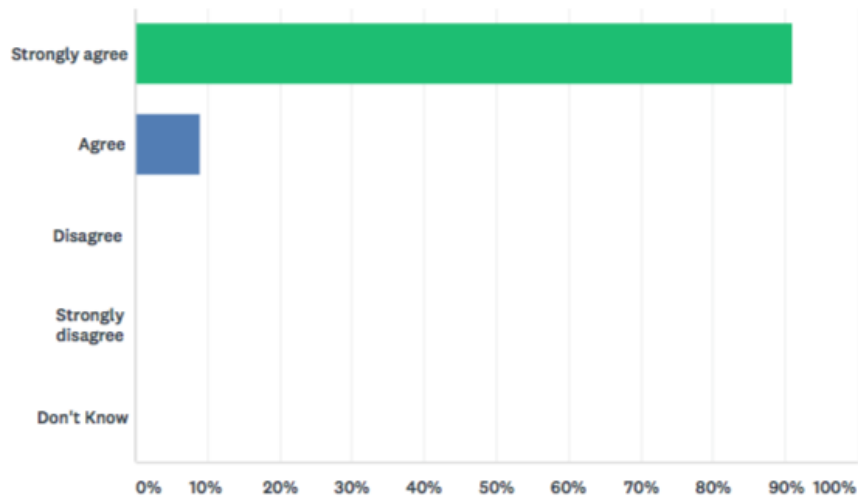
## Q3 My child is happy at their school

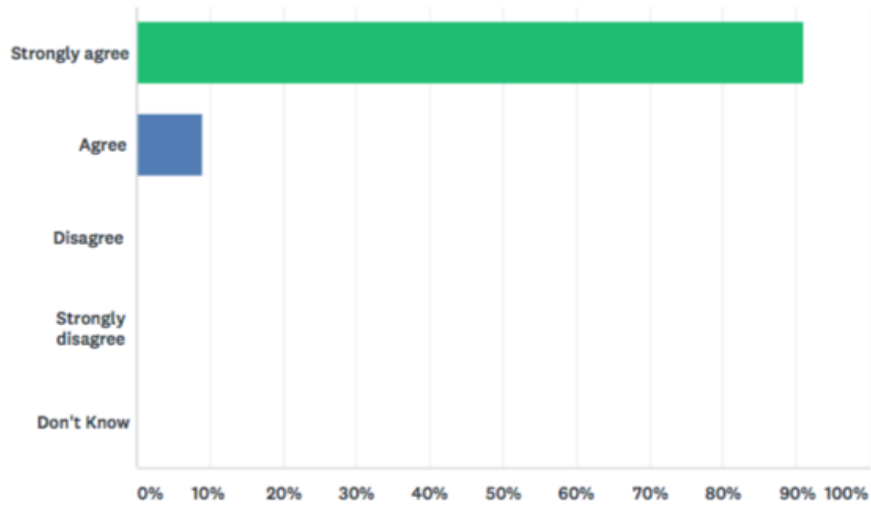
## Q4 My child feels safe at school

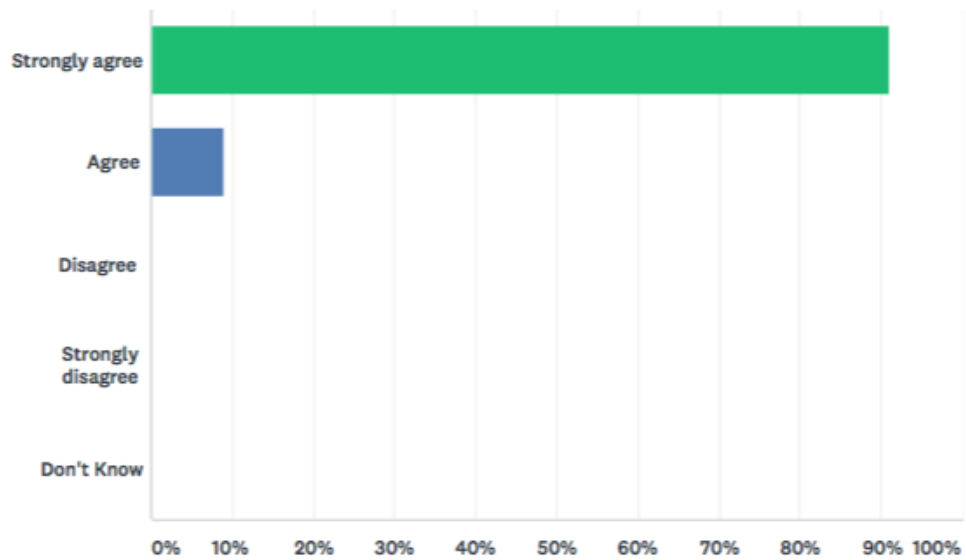
### Q5 My child is making good progress at school

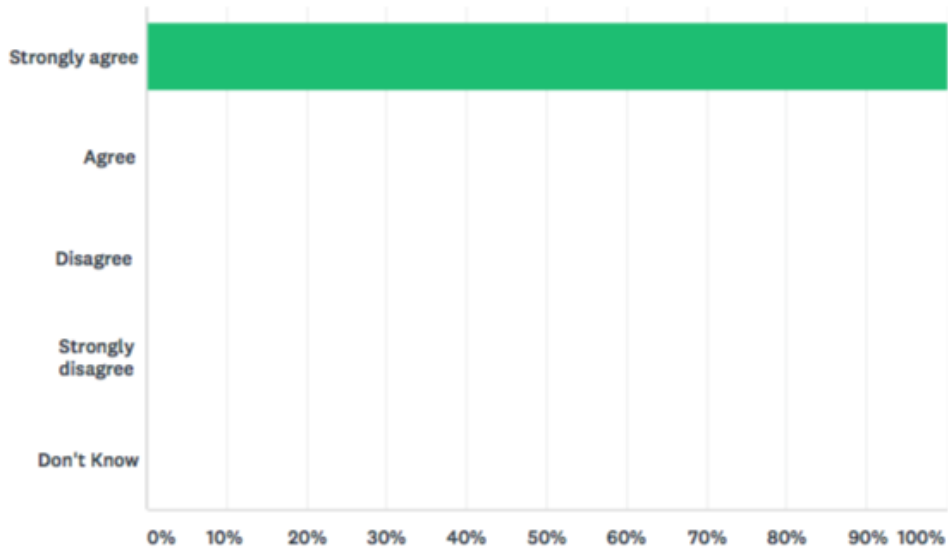
### Q6 My child is well looked after at their school

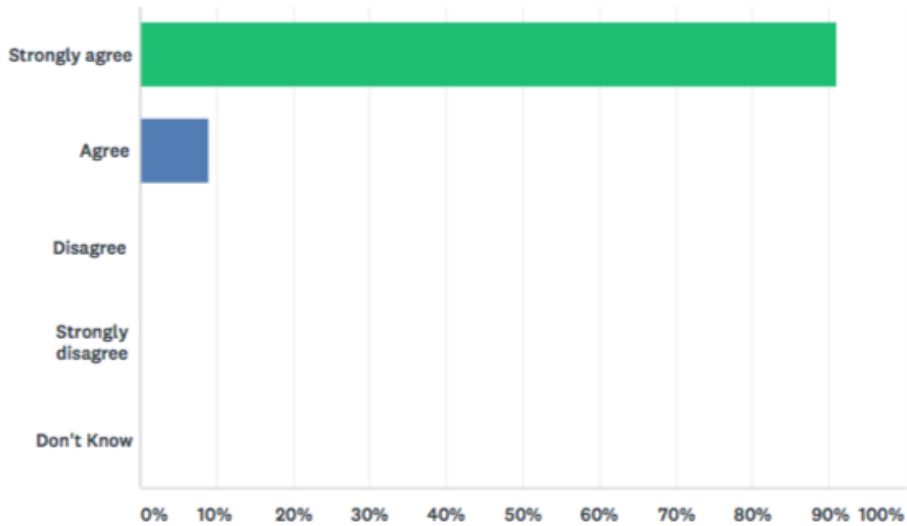
## Q7 My child is taught well at their school

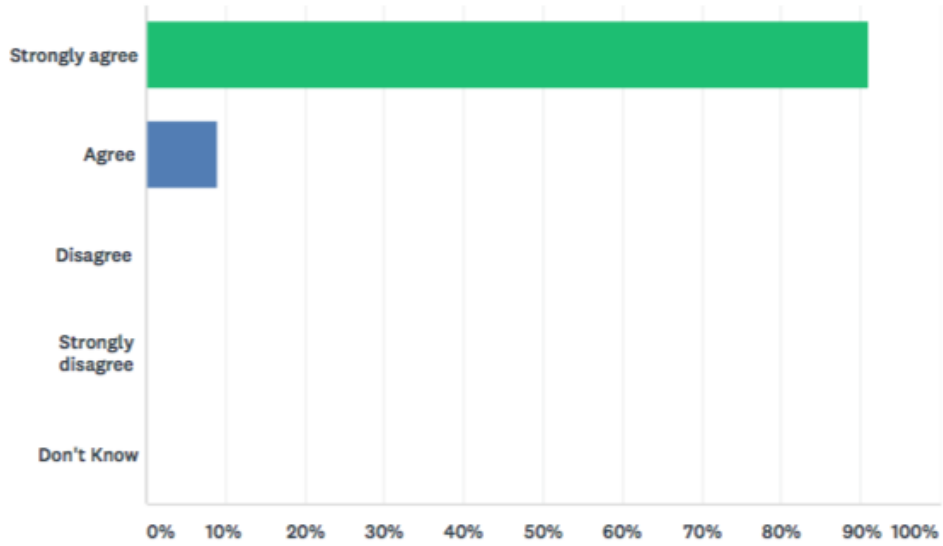
## Q8 I feel well supported by school regarding my child's needs.

### Q9 The school makes sure that all pupils are well behaved.

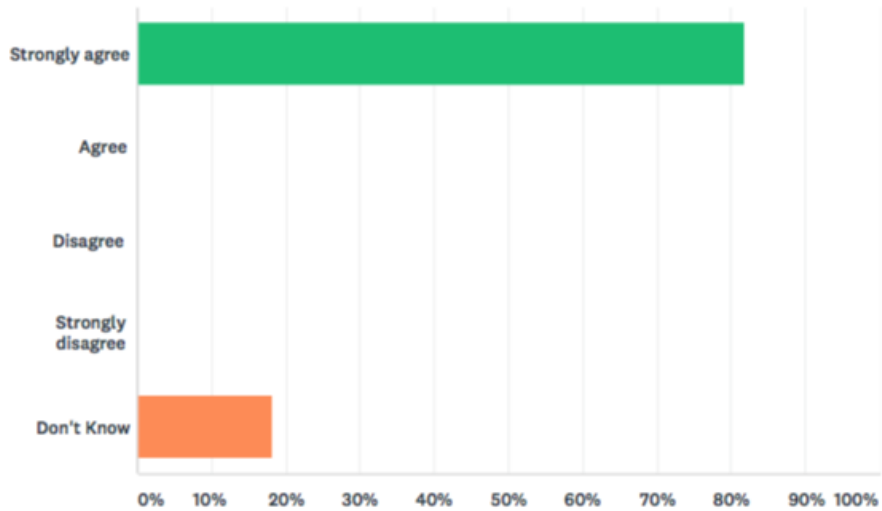

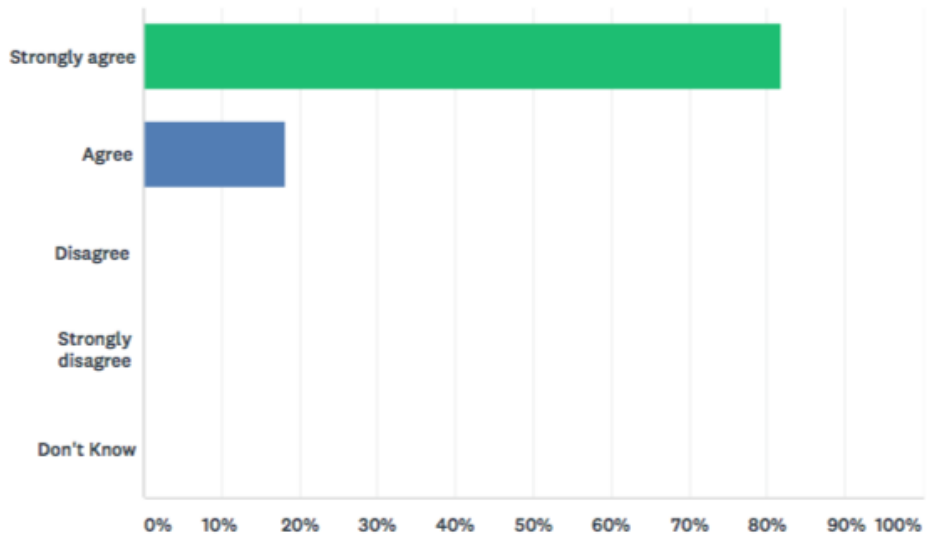
### Q10 The school deals effectively with bullying.

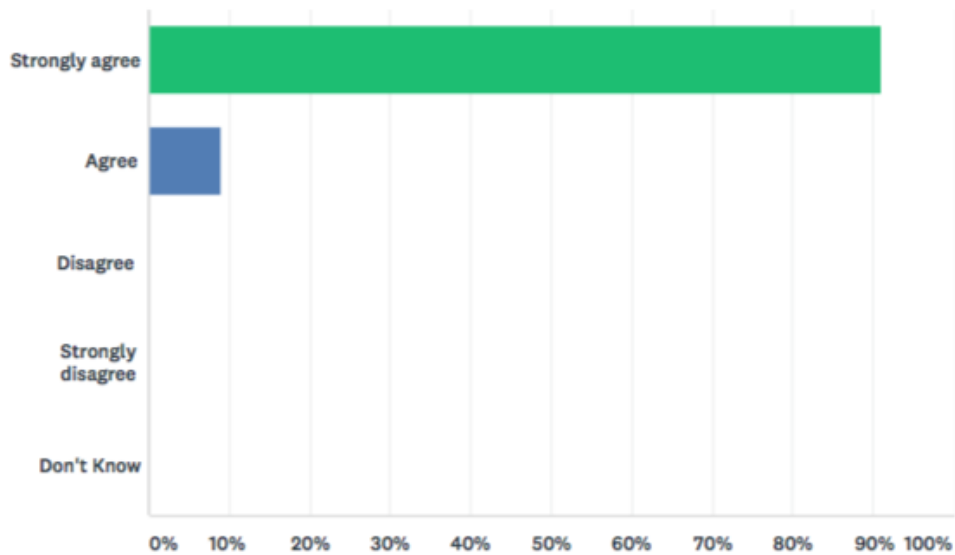
### Q11 The school is well led and managed.

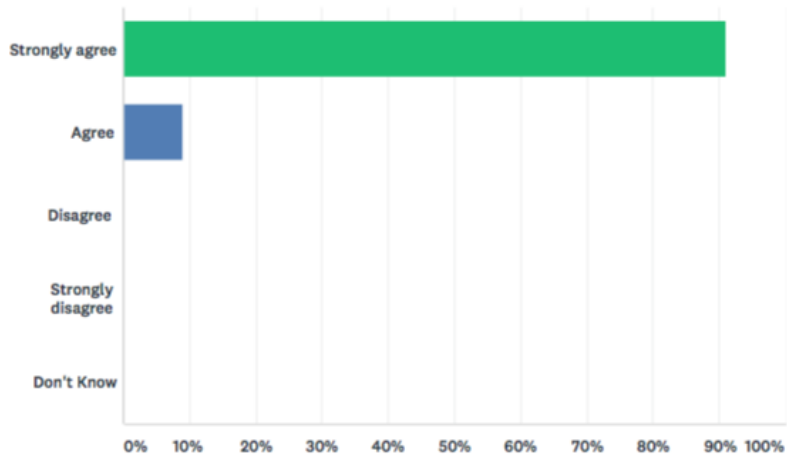
### Q12 The school responds well to any concerns I raise.

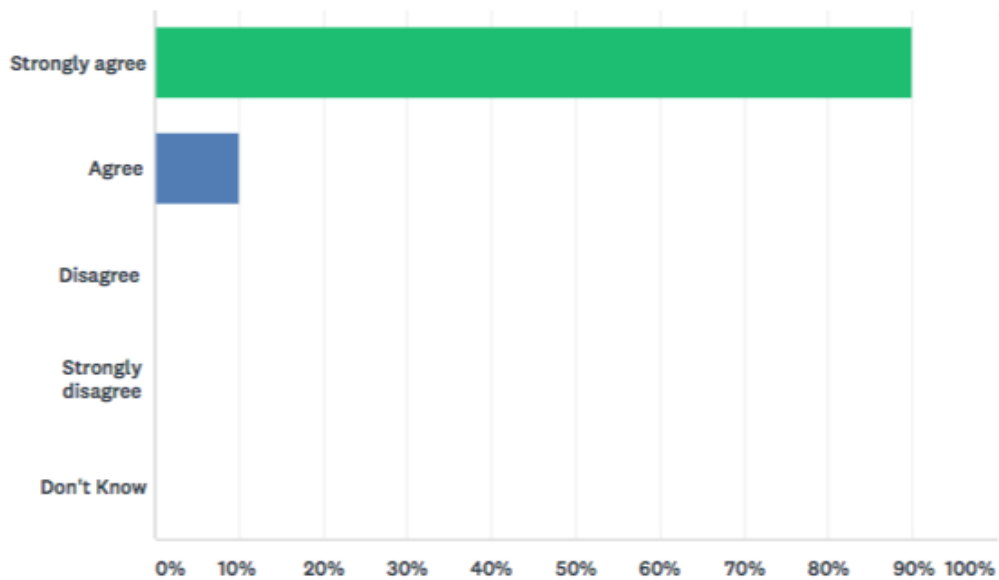
**Q13 I receive valuable information from school about my child's progress and development.**
