This term our topic is the Rock of Ages (A study of the Stone Age to the Bronze Age). Due to this, we have decided to explore Stone Age daily life for our trip. On Wednesday 12th October, the children will partake in several outdoor adventure activities. An example of some of the activities on offer includes: cooking on an open fire, tracking animals, building shelters, fire-lighting methods, and gathering wild foods. We feel this will be an excellent experience for the children to get a hands on approach to life during the Stone Age. Furthermore, as the new curriculum encourages as much outside education as possible, this will enrich your child's learning experience.

One of the reasons we have chosen this trip is also to keep costs low. As the trip will be held close to the school grounds, there is no cost for a coach. We will also get to have a full day of outdoor adventures as we do not have to allow for travel time.

To prepare for any adverse weather conditions, the children will need to bring a waterproof jacket, wellies and gloves. They will be trying lots of different activities that will keep them active and warm! The children can have a hot dinner on site as normal or can bring their own packed lunch.
